Confession

Almighty and most merciful Father, we have erred and strayed from your ways like lost sheep. We have followed the desires of our own hearts. We have broken your holy laws. We have done what we ought not to have done, and have left undone what we ought to have done. Have mercy upon us, O Lord, and forgive us our sins. Restore those who are penitent, according to your promises declared to mankind in Christ Jesus our Lord. And grant, merciful Father, for his sake, that we may live a godly and obedient life, to the praise of your holy name, Amen.

Bible reading: 2 Corinthians 4:7-18

⁷ But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us.⁸ We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair;⁹ persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed.¹⁰ We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body.¹¹ For we who are alive are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that his life may be revealed in our mortal body.¹² So then, death is at work in us, but life is at work in you.

¹³ It is written: "I believed; therefore I have spoken." With that same spirit of faith we also believe and therefore speak,¹⁴ because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus from the dead will also raise us with Jesus and present us with you in his presence.¹⁵ All this is for your benefit, so that the grace that is

reaching more and more people may cause thanksgiving to overflow to the glory of God.
16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.¹⁷ For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.¹⁸ So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

2 Corinthians 4:7-18: Don't lose heart in living and speaking for Jesus

How do we as a church feel about gospel ministry in Buxton in 2021?

Don't lose heart in living and speaking for Jesus because:

1. We're kept in weakness and suffering... so that the life of the risen Jesus is seen to work in us and sinners are saved all to God's glory (v7-12)

2. We'll be raised in glory (v13-15)

Keep speaking about Jesus Christ as Lord.

3. We're bring renewed for glory (v16-18)
