is one great aim:

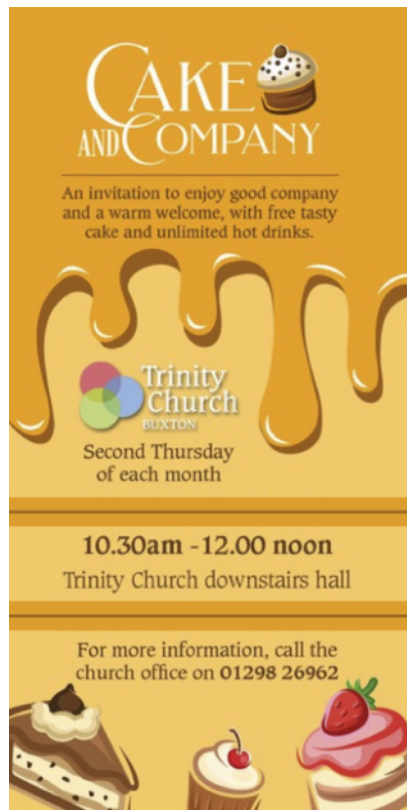
To honour God by making followers of Jesus Christ
